

HYSA Spectator Plan Fall 2020

HYSL (Rec league), Micro, ARSENAL, Academy programs

Based on documents we have submitted to Lewis and Clark County Health Department as a plan for allowing spectators at our programs; MYSA League & Academy and Recreational League (HYSL) & Micro program, and the discussions that occurred, the following is in force;

- Face Mask wearing by all spectators at practices and games as noted below
- Face Mask should cover the nose & mouth
- Social distancing of 6 feet between family groups will be in effect as noted below
- Players shall wear face masks to and from the activity and on sidelines but not during the time they are on the field in physical exertion
- No team huddles, high fives, no team high fives within team or with other team no high fives etc. with parents.
- Players; go partway across field and give parents a wave, keep your distance and give a cheer for the other team and yourselves
- Coaches and bench personnel shall wear masks at all times unless a coach is engaged in physical exertion or social distancing can be maintained
- Any adult that approaches the team to assist with an injury shall wear a face mask
- There are NO SNACKS to be given out
- Players should bring their own water bottle, and their own ball
- There are no pets/dogs allowed on the Siebel Soccer Complex
- Spectator attendance is limited only to the activity their player(s) is involved in
- Spectators will leave after their player's activity
- Spectators must stay in designated viewing areas behind white dotted lines opposite from their player's team or behind goals at a safe distance
- Arsenal and Academy players, coaches, parents refer to the Return to Play version 5 MYSA Protocols for further information

New in MYSA Return to Play Version 5 –All spectators are required to wear a mask, or maintain physical distancing of 6 feet between households. In addition, all players and coaches are required to wear a mask while on the bench, or keep a physical distancing of 6 feet. Clubs must also designate and mark technical, official, and spectator areas on each field to control distancing between groups.

The spectator plan Compliant letter from Lewis & Clark County Health Department; **This determination assumes active management of spectators to ensure adequate physical distancing is maintained between non household members at all times during the Helena Youth Soccer & Micro Soccer Leagues. In addition, all spectators must wear a face covering, as required by Governor Bullock's July 15, 2020 Directive. Please be advised, if spectators participate in Helena Youth Soccer & Micro Soccer Leagues and the total number of spectators exceeds 250, or, active management of physical distancing among spectators is compromised, or, attendees refuse to wear a face covering, the event must be shut-down to protect the public's health.**

Per Guidance from Lewis & Clark County Guidance for the Use of Facial Coverings;

If we can maintain 6 feet or recommended more distance at all times masks are not required. Persons exempted for medical reasons MUST keep 6 feet or recommended more distance at all times from other spectators without a mask.

Failure to abide by this plan will put persons in violation of our plan put forth so that we may have activities for our children, and those persons will be asked by HYSA and/or law enforcement to leave the premises for trespassing.
